Vorbach, Germany – At the SPE Automotive Award Night on 18 September 2021 in Neuss, the coveted award was presented to Novem by Andreas Stuber, Managing Director of Akro-Plastic. The award is given for innovative plastic parts and components in vehicle construction. Simply being nominated is considered a success since the submitted parts are usually of very high quality.

Günter Brenner, CEO of Novem Group: "FIAM stands for Function in Authentic Materials. Hidden under the luxury wood surface of this innovative trim element are capacitive sensors and LEDs. Until now luxury wood trim elements and electronic components were two different assemblies, but this part has all of the electronics integrated. Now the perfect luxury wood surface also serves as a smart surface for the controls."

Exclusive smart surface of luxury wood with sustainable character.

The innovative production method for the FIAM centre console combines different processes so cleverly that it results in lower plastic consumption. At the same time, it requires less space and fewer tools, which reduces the effort needed to install it – almost a minor revolution. In the future, the trim elements with their integrated functionality will fit into even the smallest of spaces. The investigation and use of natural and renewable materials such as wood, silk and paper in combination with reduced resource use leads to a sustainable strategy for the future.


Strong future through innovation.

These awards are highly respected in the plastic industry. Novem had already won the SPE Award in the Body Interior category in 2018. The win then was for the use of a new PUR system that eliminated the need for multiple sanding and polishing operations so that design edges can be produced with much greater precision and in higher quality.

At the time of submission beginning of last year, the trim element was still a prototype. So Novem won the award in the Enabler Technology category. The trend is towards tidier, cleaner car interiors with ever greater emphasis on functionality. Novem has succeeded in combining an aesthetic product with state-of-the-art functionality, setting a new benchmark. By receiving the current award, we show our competitiveness and creativity of our research.
